

What We Supply – Vista 51' 2 Bedroom

Bedding – We provide sheets for 2 queen beds, 1 twin bed and the full-size sofa sleeper. You need to bring blankets and all pillows. We also provide 2 bath towels, 2 hand towels and 2 wash clothes per person.

Bathroom – sink, toilet, shower, toilet paper, bathroom garbage bags

Generator – allows for 110-volt outlets to run air conditioning, hot tub, Keurig, toaster, microwave, electric coffee pot, DVD player, etc.

Kitchen/Appliances – is equipped with cookware, pans, dishes, cutlery, coffee pot, Keurig, toaster, microwave, kitchen towels, dishcloths, potholders, and garbage bags. Most essentials are provided. Gas range, oven, and refrigerator. The refrigerator/freezer is 8 cubic feet. The fridge storage volume is 5.60 cu. ft. and freezer storage volume is 1.70 cu. ft., similar to an RV size. The houseboat appliances (hot water heater/refrigerator/freezer/stove/oven/heaters) all run on L.P. gas.

Barbeque – a Weber gas grill is provided.

12 Volt System – Most items are run using LP or 12 volts. There is a 12-volt receptacle on each houseboat located at the helm. The 12-volt system is charged by running the outboard and/or generator.

Deck chairs – a deck table and 4 deck chairs are provided.

Ice Cooler – a large 150 qt cooler is provided

Communication – VHF Marine Band radios for ship-to-shore communication. AT&T offers good cell phone coverage on most areas of the lakes.

Heater – a gas heater is provided

Radio – AM/FM radio and CD player

Water – hot and cold lake water comes out of the faucets. A separate hand pump provides potable drinking water. There is approximately 30 gallons of drinking water on board. We recommend bringing some drinking water. A lake water wash-down hose is provided on the back deck.

Outboard – the houseboat is equipped with twin 70 horsepower Suzuki outboards

Auxiliary Fuel - a 12-volt pump is used to pump auxiliary fuel into small boats

Steering – upper and lower helm steering is available

Fishing Boat – a 14' fishing boat is included in all rentals. A motor is required. You can rent a motor from Ebel's or bring your own. You can also tow your own boat. Please let us know if you would like to reserve a 14' boat and/or motor.
