What We Supply - Voyageur 44'

Bedding – Nothing is provided. We recommend bringing sheets, blankets, and pillows (2 double beds, 2 single beds and a single sofa sleeper) or a sleeping bag for spring and fall rentals.

Bathroom – sink, toilet, shower, toilet paper, bathroom garbage bags

Kitchen/Appliances – is equipped with cookware, pans, dishes, cutlery, a stovetop percolator coffee pot, kitchen towels, dishcloths, potholders, 4 kitchen garbage bags, and 4 large garbage bags. Most essentials are provided. Dish soap is not provided.

Gas range, oven, and refrigerator. The refrigerator/freezer is 8 cubic foot. The fridge storage volume is 5.60 cu. ft. and freezer storage volume are 1.70 cu. ft., similar to an RV size.

The houseboat appliances (hot water heater/refrigerator/freezer/stove/oven/heaters) all run on L.P. gas. This eliminates the need for a generator.

Barbeque – a Weber gas grill is provided.

12 Volt System – There is no need for 110-volt outlets on the houseboat because everything is either LP or 12 volts. There is a 12-volt receptacle on each houseboat located at the helm. The 12-volt system is charged by running the outboard.

We do however offer generators for rent. You are welcome to bring your own generator. Generator operations must be carried out on shore.

Deck chairs – a deck table and 6 deck chairs are provided.

Ice Cooler – a large 150 qt cooler is provided

Communication – VHF Marine Band radios for ship-to-shore communication. AT&T offers good cell phone coverage on most areas of the lakes.

Heater – a gas heater is provided

Radio – AM/FM radio and CD player

Water – hot and cold lake water comes out of the faucets. A separate hand pump provides potable drinking water. There is approximately 20 gallons of drinking water on board. We recommend bringing some drinking water.

Outboard – the houseboat is equipped with a 70 horsepower Suzuki outboard

Auxiliary Fuel – a 12-volt pump is available to fuel small boats from an auxiliary tank

Fishing Boat – a 14' fishing boat is included in all rentals. A motor is required. You can rent a motor from Ebel's or bring your own. You can also tow your own boat. Please let us know if you would like to reserve a 14' boat and/or motor.
